Listed below are the expected behaviours of students at SEDA Group.

### Communication

- Follow instructions
- Listen when others are speaking

### Respect

- Call your teacher if you are going to be absent or late

### Academic Performance

- Attend regularly

- Complete homework
- Produce independent work without plagiarism, collusion or cheating

### Environment/Equipment

- Behave in a manner that reflects positively on the program and on yourself
- Have an enthusiastic and positive approach
- Enjoy yourself
- Wear your SEDA Group uniform at all times and wear the correct attire for activities
- Bring the necessary equipment each day
