ASSESSMENT

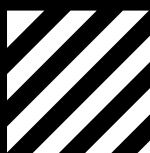
Students will be assessed using a range of different methods including but not limited to: observations, projects, written assessments, portfolio of evidence, role plays and research tasks.

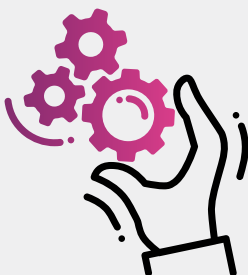
