ABOUT THE MADALAH SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

MADALAH Limited is a not-for-profit organisation that offers secondary and tertiary education scholarships for Indigenous students from remote and regional communities to Western Australia's leading boarding schools and Australian universities.

We believe education is the key to generational change and opportunity, and we are committed to making a difference in the lives of our students, their families and communities.

If you were to be successful in receiving a tertiary scholarship the scholarship funds can be utilised for the following:

- **University & Tuition Fees**
- **Text Books & Stationery**
- **Travel Related Expenses**
(e.g. petrol, university parking, car insurance & servicing)
- **IT Equipment**
(e.g. laptop, headphones or USB purchased for study)
- **Uniforms** (e.g. lab coat)
- **Living Expenses** (e.g. groceries & utility bills)
- **Boarding & Accommodation**
- **Personal Expenses**
(e.g. counselling, sports registration fees & toiletries)
- **Helpful Resources & Leadership**
(e.g. tutoring, music lessons or university camp/tour fees)

The MADALAH Scholarship funds are paid directly to the tertiary scholar in two instalments, half at the start of semester 1 and the other half at the start of semester 2.

At the end of each semester, tertiary scholars are required to complete a progress report and forward this through to MADALAH along with their latest academic results, expenditure receipts and proof of enrolment for the next semester.

WHO CAN APPLY & ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Be of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent and be able to provide proof of descent
 - Be seeking a tertiary scholarship
- Have applied or be in the process of applying to an Australian University for full-time study
 - Must provide proof of enrolment or an acceptance letter
 - Must provide most recent academic results
 - Must provide one letter from a referee
- Scholars must have a home location in Western Australia

Proof of descent can be one of the following documents:

- Letter from an Indigenous Corporation or Land Council,
- Parent's or Grandparent's proof of descent and applicant's birth certificate (if submitting proof of descent for a grandparent we will also require the parent's birth certificate)



MENTORING PROGRAM

MADALAH Tertiary Scholars based in WA have the opportunity to come on board as a MADALAH mentor.

Our Mentoring Program aims to drive learning and personal development, with other benefits including increased engagement and support, both academically and personally.

The mentoring program sees our mentors visit each of our 23 partner schools twice a term. We deliver tailored sessions that explore themes such as Storytelling & Role Modelling, Mental Health & Well-being and Leadership.

The MADALAH Mentoring Program, has seen a marked improvement in addressing the emotional well-being of our students.

The big brother / sister support structure is an additional layer that gives students an opportunity to discuss issues relating to bullying, loneliness, and fear of failure to name a few. We believe these sessions are meaningful for all involved and only add to the wrap around support already provided to students by MADALAH.

- Proof of descent
- Proof of enrolment or an acceptance letter
 - Most recent academic results
 - Referee letter
 - Photo of applicant

You will then receive an auto reply confirmation email and a staff member will also be in touch.
