CASE STUDY



After volunteering to assist Netball NT at an after-school program I was given an opportunity to work with Netball NT as a school holiday program coach. My role involved teaching the fundamental skills of netball, having fun and inclusive games for different ages and abilities and increasing participation in the sport.
